## Winnipeg Oak

Winnipeg Oak is a classic oak with an elegant appearance. The fine pore pattern, small, beautifully arranged branches, full flowers and an attractive interplay of colours make it an elegant focal point. This design is named after Winnipeg, the capital of the Canadian province Manitoba. Winnipeg is home to several museums, including the Seven Oaks House Museum. Built in 1853 by merchant John Inkster, it is said to be the oldest habitable house in Manitoba.

The Voyage decor is a contemporary interpretation of vibrant walnut. The grain of the wood structure features a striped effect with a characteristically irregular light and dark colouring. On account of the small-scaled composition of the decor, the overall look ranges from moderately rustic to sporty and elegant, while the metallic effect creates intensive brilliance of colour. The natural high-grade character of the wood is emphasised further still by an additional haptic cylinder.
